
Getting to and from GO & VIA is about to get easier

Due to increasing numbers of passengers, the GO Concourse at Union Station is a hub of activity at rush hour, and difficult to move through. The proposed new concourse areas could make it easier to access track level for GO Transit and VIA Rail. Passengers would have an entire level dedicated to train access, with many access points and limited shops and services.



- The number of access points in the Station would increase, reducing the bottle-necks that occur during rush hour
 - 1. Provide a new northwest PATH connection
 - 2. Direct access to PATH- easier route through subway concourse
 - 3. New south tunnel to Union Plaza/Air Canada Centre and Maple Leaf Square
- Improve way-finding and signage to give clear routes and directions
- New concourse areas for commuters - no longer having to compete with shoppers for space - but with some "grab and go" retail and services
- Stairs and escalators to concourses below and the PATH level would be added to provide better access to other levels of the Station and the street
