

# 512 St Clair state of good repair projects and third party works

May 2023 (Updated Summer 2023)

### **Overview**

As part of TTC's plan to maintain state of good repair and continue to modernize the system, the TTC will be coordinating streetcar overhead power upgrades to the St Clair streetcar lanes (Right of Way) and infrastructure renewal projects inside both St Clair and St Clair West Stations.

The TTC is coordinating its projects with non-TTC third party works (Metrolinx, City of Toronto and Toronto Water) to minimize inconvenience. Minor overhead power upgrade work will occur near existing streetcar infrastructure along the route (near loops, poles, pits and substations).



### **Bus service**

- As of September 3, 2023, if travelling between Gunns Road and St Clair Station, customers board buses along St. Clair Avenue (curbside).
  - The 33 Forest Hill and 126 Christie buses are boarded on St Clair Ave. West in front of St Clair West Station main entrances. The extension of 47A Lansdowne will be discontinued as of September 3, 2023.
  - At St Clair Station, customers can access 512 buses at street-level.
  - 90 Vaughan bus service will be extended to Bathurst Station starting September 3, 2023.

# Third Party Works (City of Toronto) – Rehabilitation of Rail Bridge West of Caledonia Rd

The City of Toronto is rehabilitating St. Clair Avenue West under Metrolinx Rail.

- Transit Impact:
  - During this project, 512 St Clair streetcars will not operate between Lansdowne Avenue and St Clair Avenue and Gunns Loop.
  - By September 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2023, service through the affected areas will instead be provided through a 512 bus replacement, operating along the full length of the route. Curbside stops will continue to be serviced.



## Local BIAs, businesses & CaféTO

- Upon further review, TTC can confirm that our work will not impact the CafeTO Program (businesses can keep their patios in the City ROW for the rest of the 2023 CafeTO season).
- Updates will be provided throughout station construction.



# Changes to keep transit and traffic moving

- Metrolinx, City of Toronto and TPA are working together to remove parking in key areas to improve traffic flow.
- Access to paid parking lots along St. Clair Avenue will remain available.
- Signal modifications will be made along the St. Clair corridor to improve transit and traffic flow.



# TTC St Clair West Station Construction – September 2023 start

- The majority of work will take place between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m.
- Some overnight and weekend work will be required for safety purposes.
- Some noise, dust and, vibration associated with construction at stations is unavoidable with this work. Efforts will be made to minimize.
- Construction trucks, equipment, and workers will be present in near the stations.
- Taxi stands and some bike parking adjacent to bus stops will be temporarily removed or relocated if possible.
- TTC will provide construction updates and coordinate responses to questions for its construction.
